

Family Empowerment Scholarship



Family Empowerment Scholarships - Florida's newest private education scholarship - are available to low- and middle-income families.

Students who qualify for the program can use their scholarship to attend one of the hundreds of participating private schools in Florida. But, with only 18,000 scholarships available for this school year, they won't last long.

Household income less than 300% of the 2019 federal poverty level.
